Mark 7:1-37: Opposition of the Servant

Begin by praying that God's Spirit will bless your time in His word, that He will teach you His truth, that He will meet you right where you are today as you seek Him. Next, read through the whole passage slowly. Try to step into the passage remembering that Mark is recounting real events as Peter told him.

What did He say they were neglecting?

What did He say they were experts at doing?

What were they good at keeping?

Who did Jesus quote next?

Summarize what he said.

What is Corban?

Who does Jesus accuse the religious leaders of neglecting in the name of "Corban"?

Mark 7:14-23

What did Jesus do next?

What did He say to them first?

According to Jesus teaching, what defiles a man?

How did Jesus restate the first thing He said?

What does that mean?

What did Jesus do next?

Who questioned Him next?

How did He respond?

How did Jesus declare all foods clean?

What organ did Jesus say was key?

What defiles a man?

What proceeds out of the heart of man?

(This teaching by Jesus reinforces the basic doctrine of our sin nature.)

Take some time to read back over the passage and your notes. Are there parts of this passage that stand out to you? Pray that God will continue to teach you as you meditate on His word, the story of His Son, Jesus.

Consider this:

Are there things about which you are hyper critical of others regarding?

Do you value the traditions of man more than the commandments of God?

To which traditions of man do your hold?

Which commandments of God do you neglect?

What does it mean to listen to God?

Is there something that His word is 'saying' to you, but which you're not listening to?

With which of the sinful attitudes and actions do you struggle?

How do you approach Jesus?

Are you persistent in prayer?

Why? Why not?

Has God ever worked out a good in your life in a strange, unpredictable way? Recount it here. Write about it in a journal.
